


SKILL BUILDER 5.2 Browse Web Pages

In this exercise, you will navigate to web pages with the address bar.

Live Links: These are live web links. It is possible for a link to have changed locations or to have shut down since this book was printed. A link may also be down temporarily due to technical problems. If you try a link and it does not work, go on to another link.

1. If necessary, launch Internet Explorer.
2. Navigate to the homepage of a website on the following list by typing its URL in the address bar. If you see an error message, check for a typo in the address bar and try again.

 **NOTE!** Notice that some of the URLs below use a “www” at the front. Usually, you can omit the www. However, if the site you expect does not appear, try adding www. to the front of the URL.
