

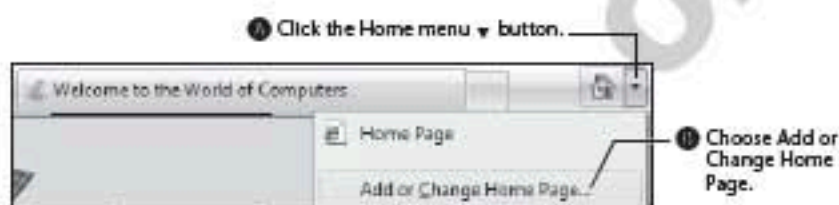


HANDS-ON 5.7 Set a Custom Homepage

In this exercise, you will set a new page as your homepage and then reset the homepage to the original homepage.

Set an Additional Homepage

1. Make sure that the Welcome to the World of Computers book page is displayed.
2. Follow these steps to add this to your homepages:



A dialog box appears asking how you wish to add this homepage.

3. Choose the Add This Webpage to Your Home Page Tabs option and click Yes. Internet Explorer adds the page to the Home button.

View Multiple Homepages

4. Close the Internet Explorer window.
5. Choose Start→Internet to restart Internet Explorer.
Notice that there are two tabs opened in Internet Explorer when you start the browser. Each homepage opens automatically in its own tab.

NOTE! If someone else has already defined any additional homepages, there might be more than two tabs visible in Internet Explorer.

6. Click the second tab to display the book web page.



Internet Explorer displays the homepage. You will learn more about tabbed browsing in the next lesson.

Remove a Homepage

7. Follow these steps to remove the newly added homepage:



Internet Explorer ask you to confirm removing this homepage.

8. Choose Yes to confirm the deletion.
Internet Explorer removes the homepage from the list. However, it is still visible in the Internet Explorer window until you navigate away from it.
9. Click the Home menu button.
Notice that the Welcome to the World of Computers web page is no longer in the list.
10. Click once on the Home button to dismiss the menu.
The student web page should remain visible.
